Educational Program and Practice

We understand the importance of providing a stimulating, engaging and a supportive educational program that caters for all children enrolled at Out of School Kids Care. Educators incorporate the My Time Our Place Framework to ensure effective learning for children of all ages, abilities and cultures. Educators undertake continual training to enhance their skills and knowledge which assists them in understanding the importance of observing children in different environments and extending their learning based on their current interests, abilities, skills and knowledge. We embrace each child's uniqueness and strive to provide experiences that promote the development of each child's identity, confidence, wellbeing and communications.

Children's Health and Safety

We recognise that all children should be supported and provided a safe and healthy environment and we strive to take every necessary measure to ensure that all children are cared for in an appropriate manner. The health and safety of children is promoted throughout the centre and educators understand the importance of catering for children's individual needs. Management will undertake regular safety audits and training to maintain a high quality centre. Educators undertake Protective Behaviour's Workshops to ensure the safety and rights of all children at all times. Educators will incorporate learning programs to educate children on the importance of caring for their bodies.

Physical Environment

Out of School Kids Care believes in creating a homely environment that is designed to educate children in a fun and exciting manner. Management ensures that all equipment and resources are well maintained. We strive to incorporate natural products into the environment and educate children on the importance of caring for the environment. The indoor and outdoor environment is designed to stimulate learning and engage children with a variety of resources, materials and experiences.

Staffing Arrangements

Before School Care and After School Care

Out of School Kids Care offers care for school aged children from Pre-Kindy to Year 6.

Our before school program runs from 7am. Your child is welcomed by warm and friendly staff who ensure they are taken to school at the correct times.

Our after school program starts from 2:30pm and staff ensure that the Centre is presented in a warm and homely way that is welcoming for each child and family. Our Educational Program is based on the National Framework “*My Time Our Place*” and each child, along with the Educators, are actively involved in creating a program that is developmentally appropriate for their age in line with specific outcomes.

The service provides a healthy afternoon tea every day during term time. There is always a selection of food for the children and we are an Allergy Aware Centre with a NO NUTS policy.

Vacation Care

During Vacation Care our Educators provide a program that has a variety of incursion and excursion activities. Excursions include going to the Cinema, Bounce, Dark Light, Ellenbrook Water Park, Kings Park and much more. Our incursion days are fun filled with a variety of activities varying from water fun days to wheels day, bake off, x-factor, the amazing race and rocket making.
